

If your child is interested in trains and rail transportation, come join us for a fun and enriching 5-day summer camp at the Southeastern Railway Museum. The theme for 2018 is "Riding the Rails".

During this year's camp, young rail enthusiasts will learn about different types of rail transportation found across our country and around the world. Campers will discover a variety of systems, old and new, including trains, subways, cable cars, monorails, street cars, incline rails, and even roller coasters! Your child will also get the experience of riding on two operating trains as part of their rail education.

Our camp is for ages 4 to 12. Campers will divide into three different age groups during the program. Children must be 4 years old at the start of the camp and no older than 12 by the end of the camp. On the last day of camp, we invite parents to join us for graduation and a train ride for everyone.
